Federal Network Services Wins Santa Monica Contract to Install Public Security Video System

Woodinville, Wa., March 16, 2006 -- Federal Network Services, Inc. today announced it has signed a \$1.3 million contract with the City of Santa Monica to install and maintain a Public Video Security System for the Santa Monica Pier and the Third Street Promenade. A key feature of the project is the integration of the Public Video Security System with the City's existing security network.

Federal Network Services (www.fnsnet.com) will install a total of 123 security cameras - 61 on the Pier and 62 installed on the Promenade -- to aid in the detection and investigation of suspicious activity, including potential acts of terrorism.

"We are pleased to support the City's efforts to enhance security in these popular landmark areas of the City," said Doug Chesler, Federal Network Services president. "In designing the Santa Monica Pier and Third Street Promenade project, Federal Network Services offers the same level of experience in linking networks and providing for the secure transmission and storage of data as it does for its many U.S. Government and state information technology projects."

Federal Network Services recently completed video security system projects for the Veterans Administration Medical Center and clinics in Las Vegas and the SBX-1 Platform for the Missile Defense Agency.

The Santa Monica Public Video Security System network will link the video cameras to the City's computer network for convenient monitoring. In addition, video from the cameras will be stored on a secure digital storage system, on equipment housed in the City's Public Safety Facility.

Federal Network Services was selected by the City Council as the best-qualified provider following an evaluation by the City of a test system temporarily installed on the Pier and Promenade. The corporation's partners include IndigoVision, Bosch, Enterprise Security, Overland Storage and Cisco. Installation of the security cameras and network will be completed in approximately 10 weeks.
